

# christmas tree quantity

## THE DETAILS FOR MY 9' TREE

**Lights:** 12 boxes of 100 clear lights

**Specialty Lights:** 2 strands of random throbbing lights

**Picks:** 54 individual branches

**Garlands:** If I use any this year, I will likely add 6-10 strands of beads or something like that to my tree

**Balls and Baubles:** I anticipate around 400 balls and ornaments. Remember many are used deep into the tree.

**Ribbons:** 9 rolls of ribbon (10' rolls)

**Bows:** I will decide if bows are needed as I go

**Spinners:** 15 spinners



## DETERMINE THE QUANTITIES YOU WILL NEED BASED ON YOUR TREE HEIGHT

### Lights:

100 - 150 strands of lights per foot

### Specialty Lights:

1-2 strands of throbbing lights for center of tree

### Picks:

I love floral picks in on a tree to add texture and dimension to a tree. I typically use up to 6 pic branches per foot.

### Garlands:

9' strand of garland... 1 strand per foot of tree.

### Balls and Baubles:

This is a matter of preference but I typically use 25 - 50 balls, baubles or ornaments per foot. The bottom branches are wider and will require more of course, but as the tree moves up and gets narrower, the number decreases as well as the size of the balls.

### Ribbons:

10' rolls

1 roll per foot of tree

### Bows:

Each traditional bow takes apron 3 yard.

You will get 3+ bows for each 10' room of ribbon.

I estimate 1-2 bows per foot of tree

### Rotating SPINNERS

No less than 12 for a medium size tree.

The larger the tree, more spinners will be needed.

*tip: start shopping early!*
